

A Statement of Commitment to the Expectations
for Board of Director Members of Peace Lutheran Church

- Comply with all Board of Director policies as contained in the Peace Board of Directors Manual.
- Actively grow in the knowledge of the various Peace ministries.
- Actively grow in the knowledge and understanding of LCMS ministries and services.
- Positively represent Peace in the community.
- Respect and support the Senior Pastor’s operation of Peace ministries within its mission statement, core values, strategic plan and policies.
- Keep confidential all Peace and Peace Foundation business and personnel information that has not been made public.

Peace Board of Director Members are also strongly encouraged to:

- Participate in events at Peace.
- Support Peace and the Peace Foundation by participating in fund raising events.
- Support Peace and the Peace Foundation with their personal skills, abilities and, to the extent possible, financial contributions.
